Our family strengthening program focuses on cultivating resilience, nurturing healthy relationships, and fostering growth within the family. We are dedicated to supporting families and individuals in our community by offering a range of programs and services designed to enhance well-being, promote healthy relationships and foster growth. Our center is a safe and welcoming space where you can find the resources and assistance you need to flourish.

#### **Services**

At the core of our programs is the belief that strong families are the foundation of our communities, particularly in this district of 'Ewa. We utilize a holistic approach that recognizes the unique qualities of each parent and 'ohana circumstance and the importance of cultural sensitivity. By building upon existing strengths and providing supports based on these strengths, we help families navigate difficult and uncertain times and circumstances, with the intent of helping families emerge stronger.

#### **Services We Offer**

'Ohana Success Coaching - Our experienced and compassionate Success Coaches are here to listen, guide and provide the supports necessary to work through and overcome stressful situations. Whether facing communication

issues, transitions, or unexpected stressors, our restorative sessions offer a safe space for growth and healing. We understand that life can sometimes be challenging. We offer opportunities for growth in the areas of: building resilience through managing stress, coping skills and problem solving techniques so that you become better equipped to navigate your way through adversity.

### Parent-Child Relationship Enhancement -

Strengthening the bond between parents and children is key to your 'ohana well-being, and comes with the understanding that you are your child's first teacher.

Parenting Classes - We offer Kamalama Parenting curriculum, a metaphoric values-based model. Authored by Hale Kipa CEO, Venus Rosete-Medeiros. Kamalama, meaning "the light," is designed to be a 10 week course, with each class session incorporating Hawaiian values and parenting principles together.

Cultural Engagement - Embracing and celebrating cultural heritage is vital to the 'ohana identity. We integrate cultural activities, traditions and teachings to reinforce the importance of cultural roots that creates a sense of belonging for each family member.

Emergency Shelter Services - Emergency shelter services for single mothers or single fathers up to two families at a time, is a crucial support to families experiencing homelessness or crisis situations. This service is aimed to ensure the safety, protection, and stability of the 'ohana as they navigate through difficult, yet temporary circumstances.

Community Engagement - We believe in the strength of community connections. We help to facilitate networking events, family strengthening activities, gatherings and collaborative projects that promotes a community where families can share experiences and resources.


