Emergency Shelters (ESH) Services

Hale Kipa operates several types of shelters on O'ahu offering emergency services for youth through age 17. Our shelters are open to youth who have been abused, or are neglected, unsheltered, or facing a personal crisis.

Our **Pu'uhonua 'o Keikikane** (Boys' Emergency Shelter) houses eight males at a time, ages 12 through 17.

Our **Pu'uhonua 'o Kaikamahine** (Girls' Emergency Shelter) houses eight females at a time, ages 12 through 17.

All of our emergency shelters accept selfreferrals as well as referrals from Child Protective Services, Family Court, parents, and youth agencies.

Population and Eligibility Criteria

- Youth ages 12 through 17
- Physical and TB clearances
- Youth Responsibilities
- Participate in program activities
- Participate in supportive services (groups, recreation, etc.)
- Attend an educational program
- Youth (and family) willing to comply with program expectations


